Kia ora koutou,

As you no doubt know, New Zealand (except for Auckland and Northland) will move to Alert Level 3 at 11.59pm on Tuesday 31 August. At Alert Level 3, young people should continue to learn from home.

The Rangiora High School campus will only be open for those tamariki (children) whose parents/whānau:

- **have to return to work or are working** and
- have **children under the age of 14 years of age** who require supervision.

We ask that **only parents/whānau in the above situation** complete [this Google form](#) by midday on Monday 30 August to assist us in establishing Alert Level 3 bubbles.

Please be aware that on-site school will operate in a very different way to how we normally operate. We will organise students into bubbles of 10-20 students who will work on their online learning programmes supervised by teachers/relievers who work only within that bubble.

The Canteen will not be open during Alert Level 3. Please ensure your child(ren) bring sufficient snacks, drinks and lunch. Uniforms need not be worn.
